- Sanade and others (British children – Zambrano – Dereci) [2012] UKUT 00048 (IAC): Upper Tribunal reported case regarding deportation, the best interests of children, the rights of EU national children.
- KR (Nepal) v Secretary of State for the Home Department [2010] EWCA Civ 1619: A Court of Appeal case regarding consent orders and costs and judicial process in the higher courts.
- R v Mubbashar Rana [2007] EWCA Crim 2261: An appeal in the Court of Appeal regarding whether a judge had been entitled to give a direction to a jury pursuant to the Criminal Justice and Public Order Act 1994 s.34 and modify it accordingly rather than giving a lies direction.
- Iqbal v DPP [2004] EWHC 2567: Appeal by way of case stated regarding the admissibility of pre-caution comments, material averment in charge and the business documents exception to the hearsay rule.
- R (on the application of White) v Barking Magistrates Court [2004] EWHC 417 (Admin): A judicial review case regarding whether a legitimate expectation was given to the claimant by the defendant magistrates' court that it would sentence him in a particular way for a serious drugs offence.
